

ASPL Next Steps Campaign

ASPL has been providing educational programming and publications to educate pharmacist-attorneys, pharmacists, attorneys and other interested parties on legal issues that affect pharmacy since 1974. As a voluntary non-profit organization, ASPL has always relied on modest dues from members and contributions from others in order to provide its services. In 2003, then-President Gary Cacciatore first introduced the Next Steps Campaign, a three-year program aimed at raising \$200,000. The Campaign provides an opportunity for individuals and organizations to make contributions that will broaden the reach of our educational offerings, launch some exciting new projects and services, and to help the society grow to reach its fullest potential. There are four categories to which you can contribute. The four categories are listed below.

Operational Excellence Fund

With a goal of \$100,000, the Operational Excellence Fund is supported by unrestricted gifts to be used by ASPL to maintain existing programs and services, including administration and fundraising, and to develop and implement new programs and services. To date, funds contributed have been used to develop the attorney referral service and the expert witness listing service, expand the website, and assist with cash flow when needed. In the future, Operational Excellence funds may be invested long-term to insure the financial stability of the Association.

Pharmacy Law Symposium

With a goal of \$25,000, plans have begun for a Symposium that will bring together leaders in pharmacy and pharmacy law to present papers and address developing pharmacy jurisprudence. ASPL has already received expressions of interest from several pharmacy and law schools interested in partnering with ASPL on the development of this program. The ASPL Finance & Development Committee has targeted this program as a priority in 2005 to begin implementation.

Pharmacy Law Resource Center

The pharmacy and legal professions needs a single, comprehensive, reliable resource they can turn to for information on relevant pharmacy law issues. We believe ASPL should be the source of that information. This web-based information center would include a searchable database of articles on pharmacy law topics, information on current legal and regulatory issues in pharmacy, legislative and regulatory research tools and links to other useful sites.

Scholarship Fund

Established specifically for instructors of pharmacy law that will allow for their attendance to ASPL educational programming to further enhance their knowledge of the legal issues impacting the practice of pharmacy. The goal for this fund is \$25,000.
